"Challenges and opportunities ahead" – Interview with Clemens Frey

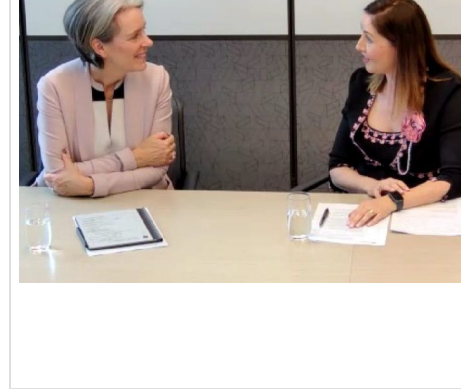


