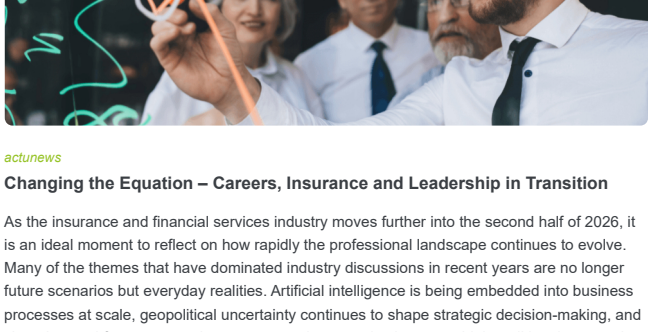

Changing the Equation – Careers, Insurance and Leadership in Transition

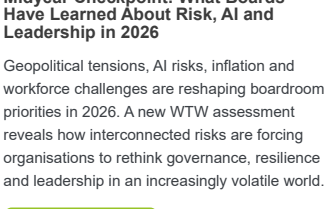
